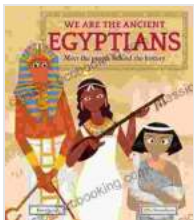

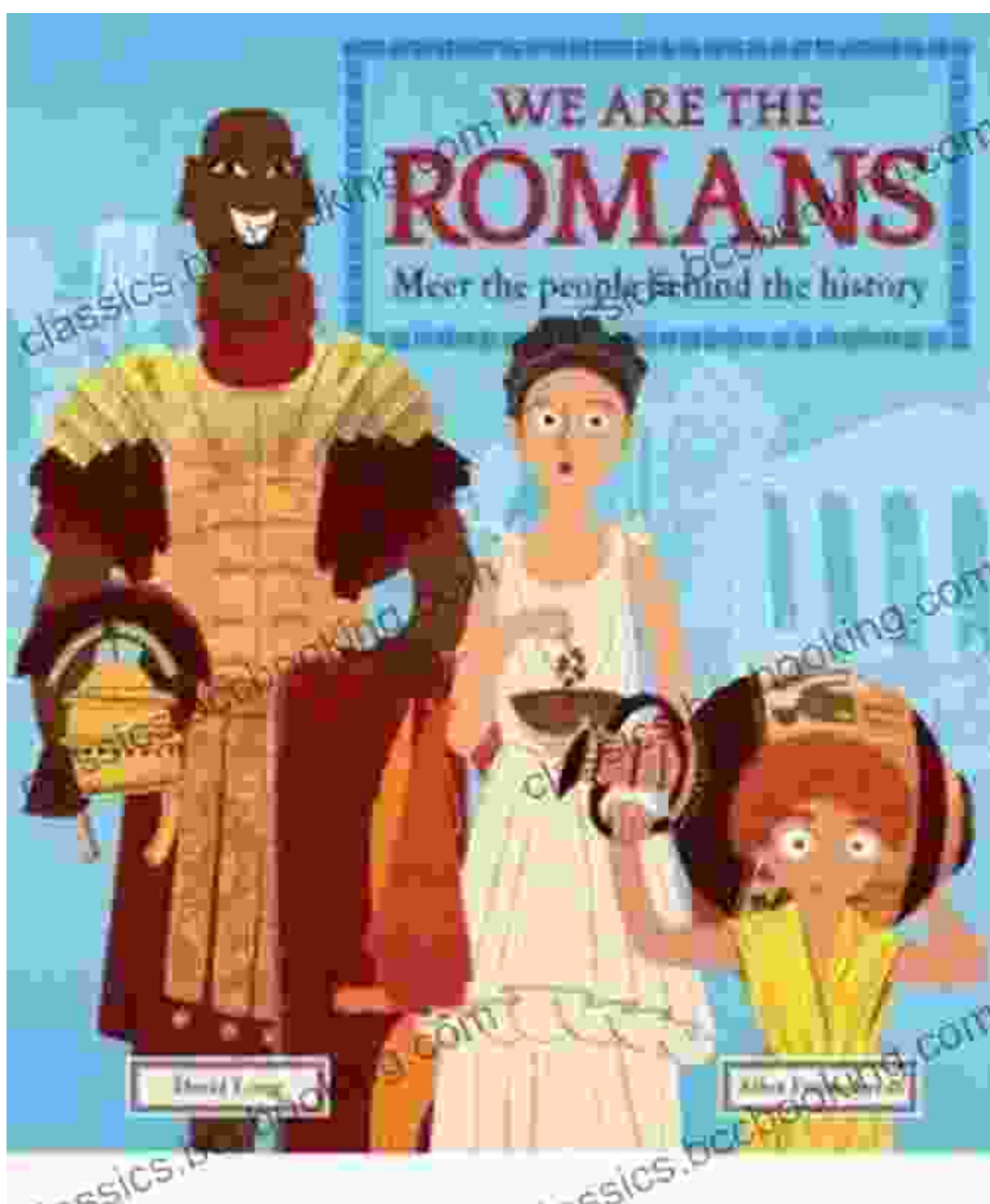

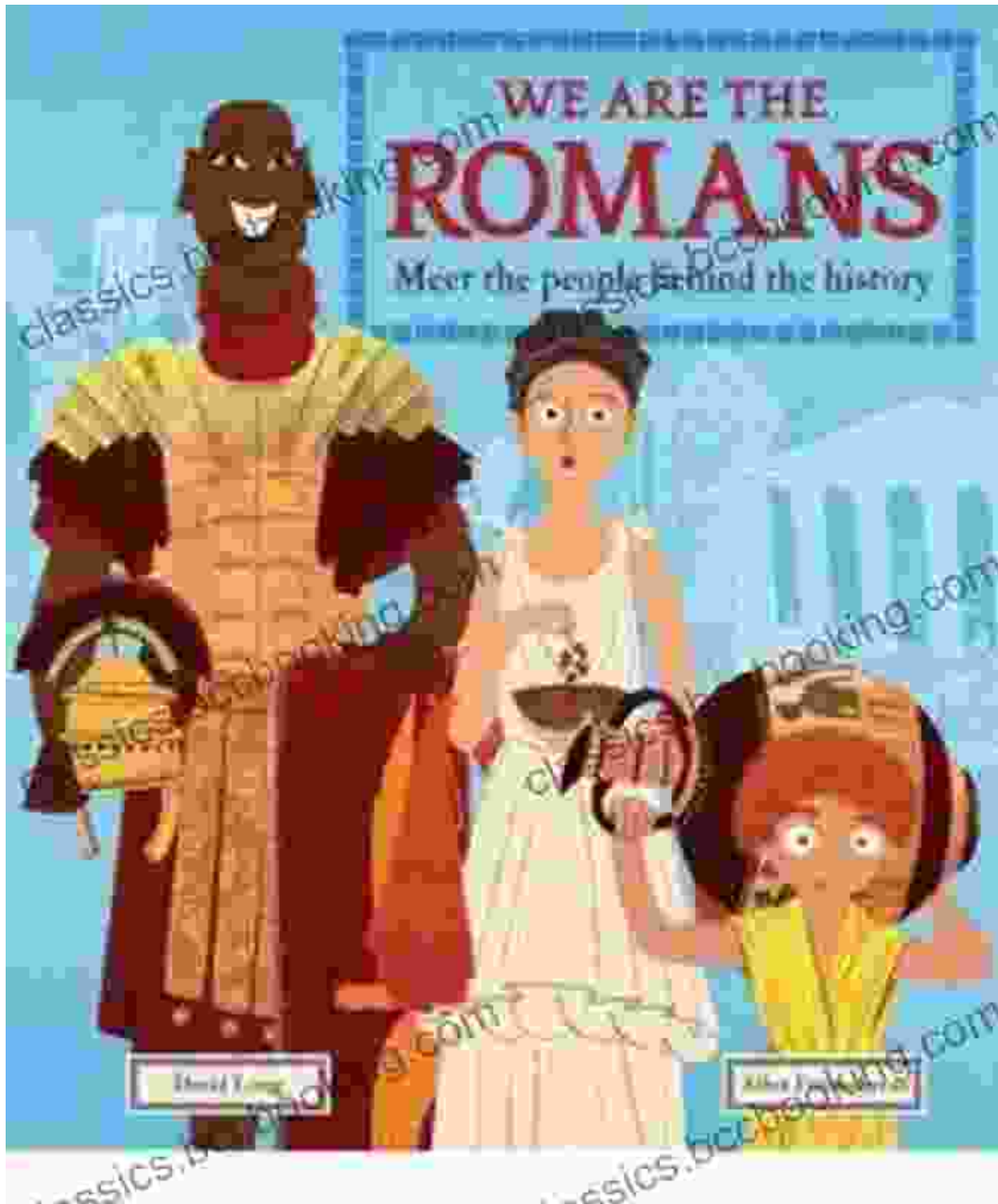

Rosa Parks: The Mother of the Civil Rights Movement



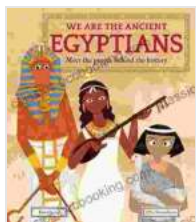
