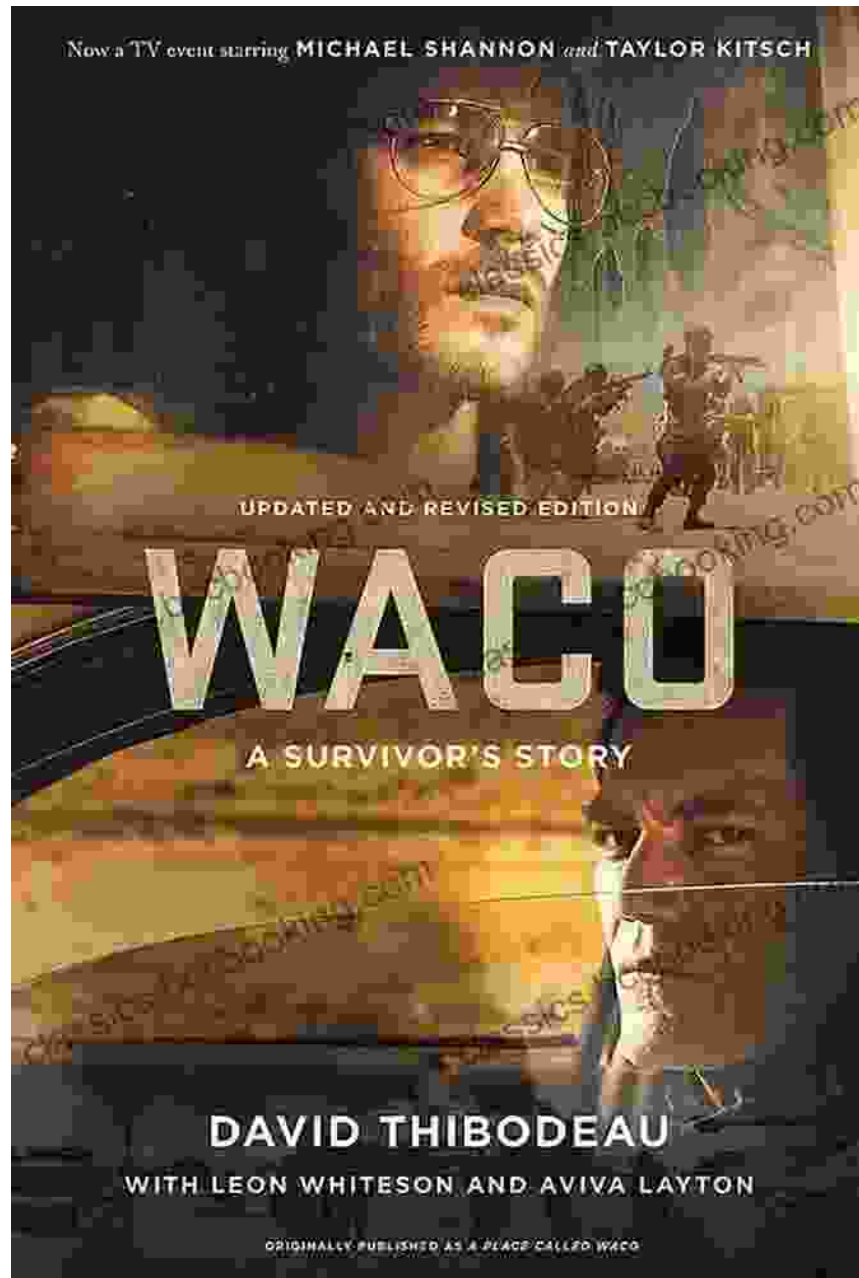


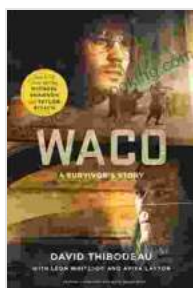

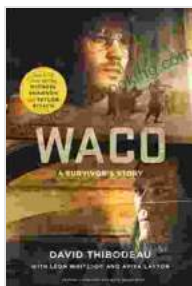
About the Author
